Free transportation service provided by the Town of Wake Forest and the City of Raleigh using Capital Area Transit vehicles.

The Wake Forest Loop is provided through a partnership between the Town of Wake Forest, the City of Raleigh and Capital Area Transit (CAT). All buses are CAT vehicles.

Accessibility

The Town of Wake Forest is committed to offering a bus system that residents of all abilities can enjoy. All buses are wheelchair accessible and offer talking bus features for the visually impaired. If you have limited mobility, please ask the driver to lower the bus so that you may step aboard.

ADA Accessible Paratransit Services

If you are a Wake Forest resident with a physical or mental disability that makes it impossible to drive a car and/or use Wake Forest Bus Service, you may qualify for the Accessible Raleigh Transportation Program (ART). This program provides subsidized curb-to-curb transportation service through participating contractors. The program in Wake

Forest is administered by the City of Raleigh and funded by the Town of Wake Forest. Call (919) 435-9441.

Can I bring my bike on the bus?

Yes. Buses can carry two bicycles on the front of the vehicle. Adult and children's sized bikes fit on the rack.

Park and Ride Lot

The Wake Forest Park and Ride Lot is located in the downtown area on **South White Street** at the **Elm Avenue** intersection. Parking is free. To see all the Park and Ride lots available in the area, visit www.getriangle.org.

Tips for riding the bus

- The bus will stop at designated bus stop signs along the route. To board the bus, signal to the driver as he approaches the stop.
- When you want to exit the bus, press the strip or pull the cord located above the seats at least one-half block before your stop.
- Whenever possible, exit the bus through the rear doors.
