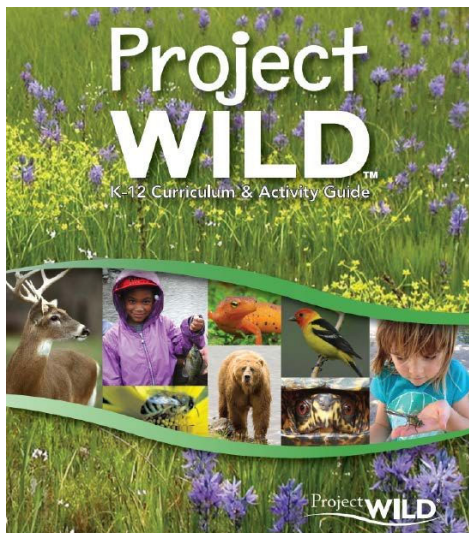

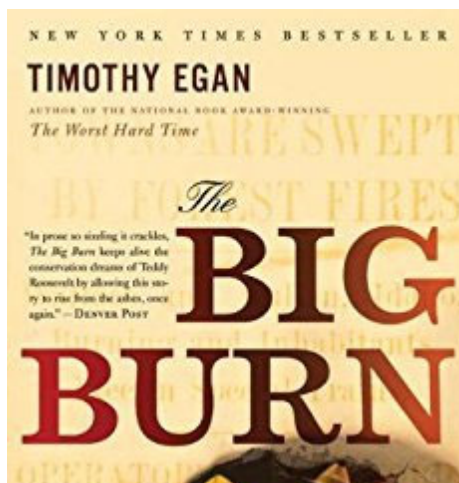
Wild Reads
