

Basic Trip Information

Departure Site: All trips will depart from the Anne Gordon Center for Active Adults at Millbrook Exchange Park (1901 Spring Forest Road, Raleigh). Vehicles may be parked at the facility for overnight trips.

Transportation: All trips will take place on a chartered motor coach or a Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Department bus or van and will be noted on trip itineraries. Smoking is not allowed on the vehicles and we ask that smoking is done at least 100 yards from the bus. Rest stops are made periodically throughout the trip. Seating is available on a first-come first-serve basis on the day of the trip. We are unable to accommodate special requests or reserve seats on vehicles. Seat rotation will only be used on multi-day trips.

Escorts: A Raleigh Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Department Adult Program employee escorts all trips. Their job is to ensure that each patrons trip needs are met. Escorts do not provide any one-on-one services.

Patron Expectations: Trip flyers will include the expected amount of walking, including any stairs. Patron must be able to keep to the scheduled timeline of the trip.

Reservation Policy: Trip reservations are accepted on a first-come first-serve basis with payment and a completed registration form. Spaces reserved when a deposit/payment has been received. Reservations may be made over the phone with full payment.

Payments/Deposits: Trip itineraries will indicate due dates for the deposit and balance. Payments can be made by check or credit card. One-day trips require full payment with the reservation. Reservations are held with a payment and there is no early registration for trips. Patrons may place money on their account to be used for future trips.

Cancellation Policy: Cancellations must be made in writing at least 14 days prior to the trip departure date to receive a refund. Full or partial refunds will be made only if a replacement can be found and are subject to non-refundable expenses incurred by the department. If Raleigh Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Department cancels a trip, a full refund will be given. No shows for trips will not receive a refund.

2015 One-Day Trips

April - House in the Horseshoe - Visit this circa 1770 plantation house which was attacked during the American Revolution and is still riddled with bullet holes. The house is known for elaborate woodworking, beautiful antiques, as well as the owner's scandalous life.

May - Wilmington, NC - Tour the Bellamy Mansion, walk along the waterfront, shop at the Cotton Exchange and enjoy lunch on the river.

June - Hamlet, NC - Explore the history of the Seaboard Railroad Depot & Museum. The museum is located in the only Victorian Queen Anne train station in NC which still serves as an active Amtrak station.

September - Raleigh, NC - Marvel at the James B. Hunt Jr. Library technology with its unusual seating and robotic book retrieval. Learn about NC Highway Patrolmen and how they are trained and live on site, see vehicles and equipment they use, and hear the stories of those who have lost their lives while serving.

October - Newton, NC - Step back in time at the Hart Square Festival. For more than 30 years Dr. Robert Hart has restored the 19th century NC lifestyle, recreating an entire village, Hart Square, which includes the largest collection of original historic log buildings.

November - Kinston, NC - Civil war enthusiasts will enjoy visiting several sites pertaining to the Battle of Kinston during the Civil War including a visit to a full size replica of a Confederate gunboat.



2015 Multi-Day Trips

May - Washington, DC - Explore the areas museums, historical sights and the highlights of our nation's capital.

September - Outer Banks - Enjoy some relaxing time at the beach while exploring all that the area has to offer from Kitty Hawk, Jockeys' Ridge, historical site, shopping and much more.

October - NC Mountains - See several areas of the North Carolina mountains from Blowing Rock to Asheville while traveling the Blue Ridge Parkway.

December - San Antonio, TX - What a way to enjoy the holiday season with warm weather and the beautiful Riverwalk decked out in lights! This trip will include the Alamo, historical sights, shopping and the story of Texas.
