Annual Volunteer Awards

2015 Call for Nominations

Categories:

1. **Outstanding Volunteer** – This award honors an HRM Program volunteer who goes above and beyond to help the program consistently. This volunteer has given the highest level of service to the program and has been instrumental in moving the HRM Program forward. The Outstanding Program Volunteer award should be awarded to a volunteer working in an operational (day-to-day) capacity.
2. **Outstanding New Volunteer** – This award honors the most distinguished first year volunteer to the HRM Program. The Outstanding New Volunteer Award can be given to a volunteer assisting at any HRM site.
3. **Stewardship Award** – The Stewardship Award honors an HRM Program volunteer that demonstrates a professional ethic towards objects of material culture or other historical assets in the program. This could include, but is not limited to, assisting with inventory or accessioning of collection pieces or helping with preservation or conservation projects.
4. **Richard Stanhope Pullen Award** – The Richard Stanhope Pullen Award is given to the outstanding financial or in-kind contributions to the HRM program. The Director of the City of Raleigh Museum, the Historic Sites Manager, and the Administrator of the Historic Resources and Museum Program should give input when nominations are considered for this award.
5. **Maclura Award** – The Maclura Award is given to a volunteer whose work within the HRM Program often goes unnoticed. This award can be given to a volunteer working in any capacity at any HRM site.
6. **Patty Mordecai Award** – The Patty Mordecai Award is given to the volunteer who worked the most hours between January 1, 2014 and December 31, 2014. Each program area (Museums, Sites, Amusements, and Collections) should submit the volunteer from their site(s) that worked the most hours in the previous year.
7. **Outstanding Group Project Award** – The Group Project Award should go to the volunteer group that has given the greatest contribution while completing a short term project at any of the HRM sites.
8. **Outstanding Teen Volunteer Award** – The Teen Volunteer Award should be awarded to a teenage volunteer who has given their time and energy to assisting the HRM Program.
